

Issues shaping the election in Georgia

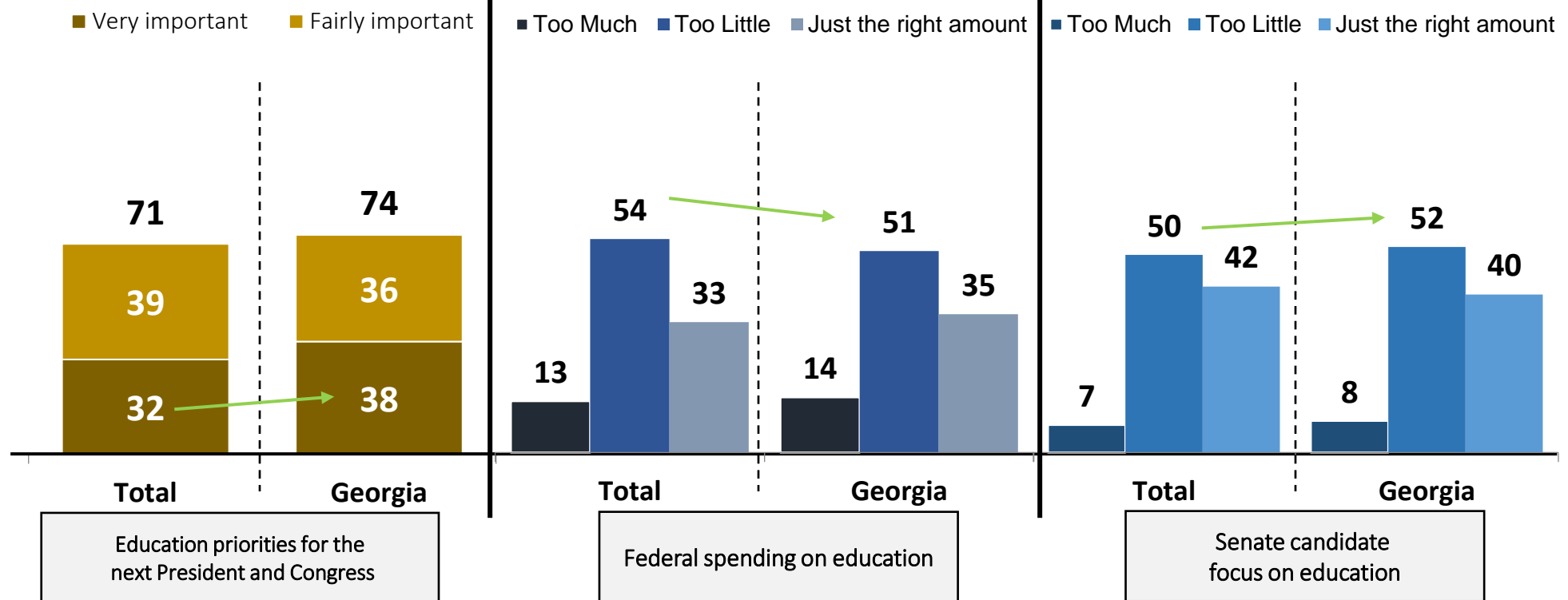
Education is a higher priority for government and candidates in Georgia compared to other states, but more are satisfied with current spending

FEDERAL FOCUS ON EDUCATION BATTLEGROUND VS. GEORGIA COMPARISON

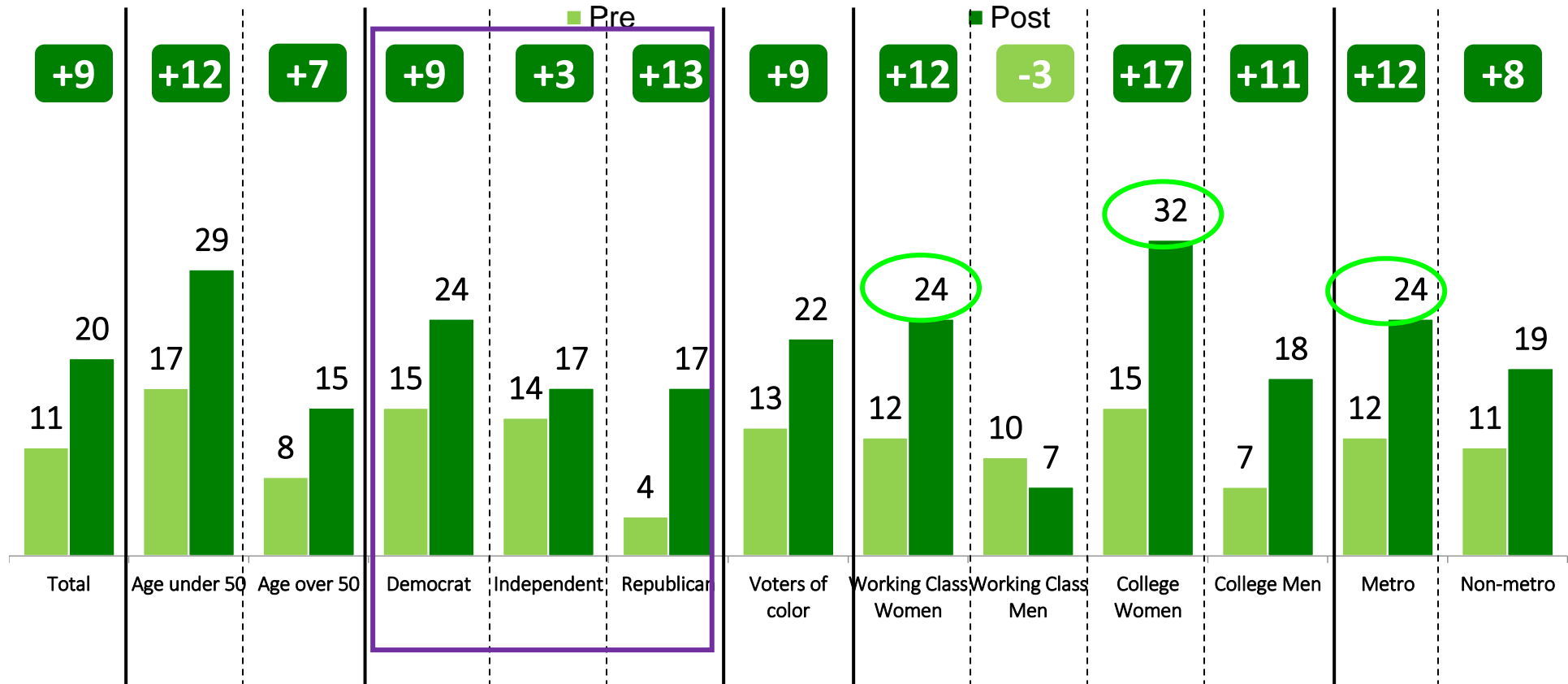


Education has broad bipartisan potential in Georgia—Democrats and Independents start high and grow, with major shift among Republicans

INITIAL TO FINAL SHIFT ON EDUCATION



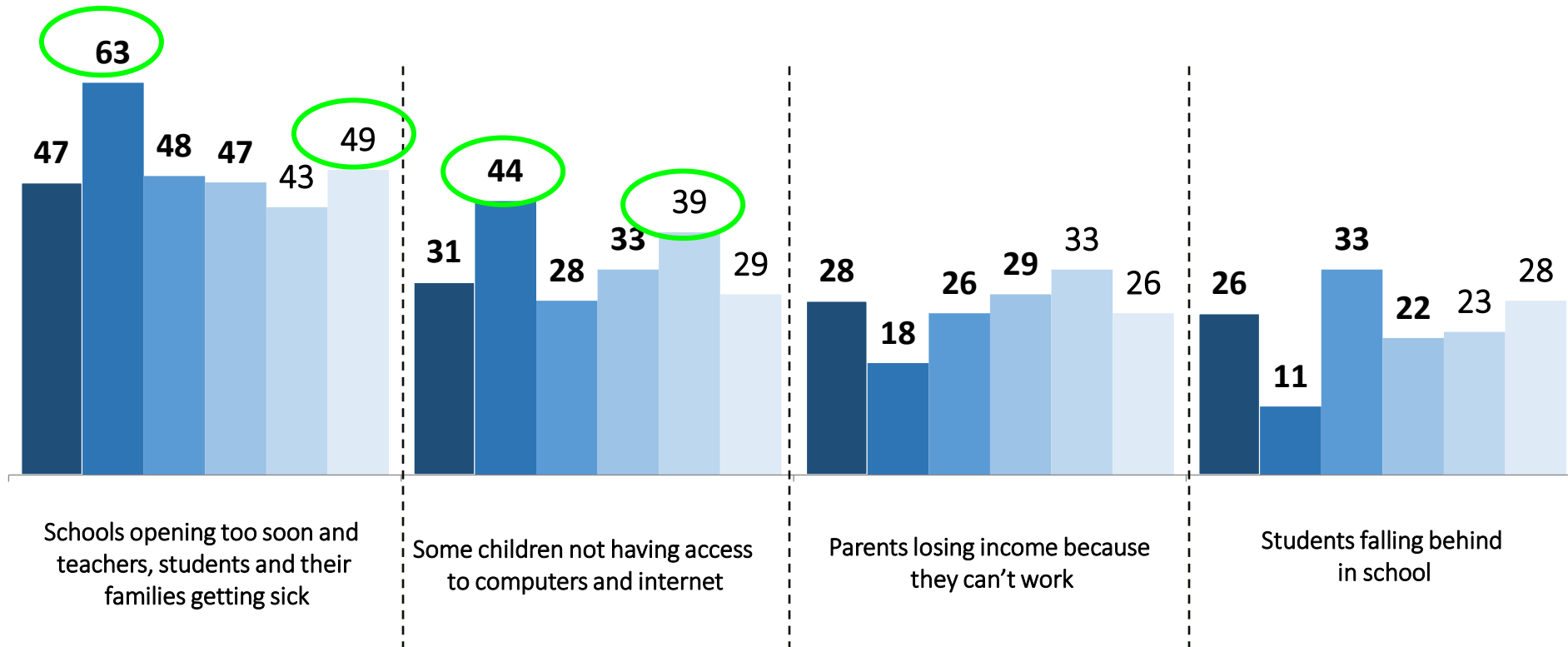
Safety and children not having access to internet and computers is a particularly high concern for voters of color and voters outside the cities

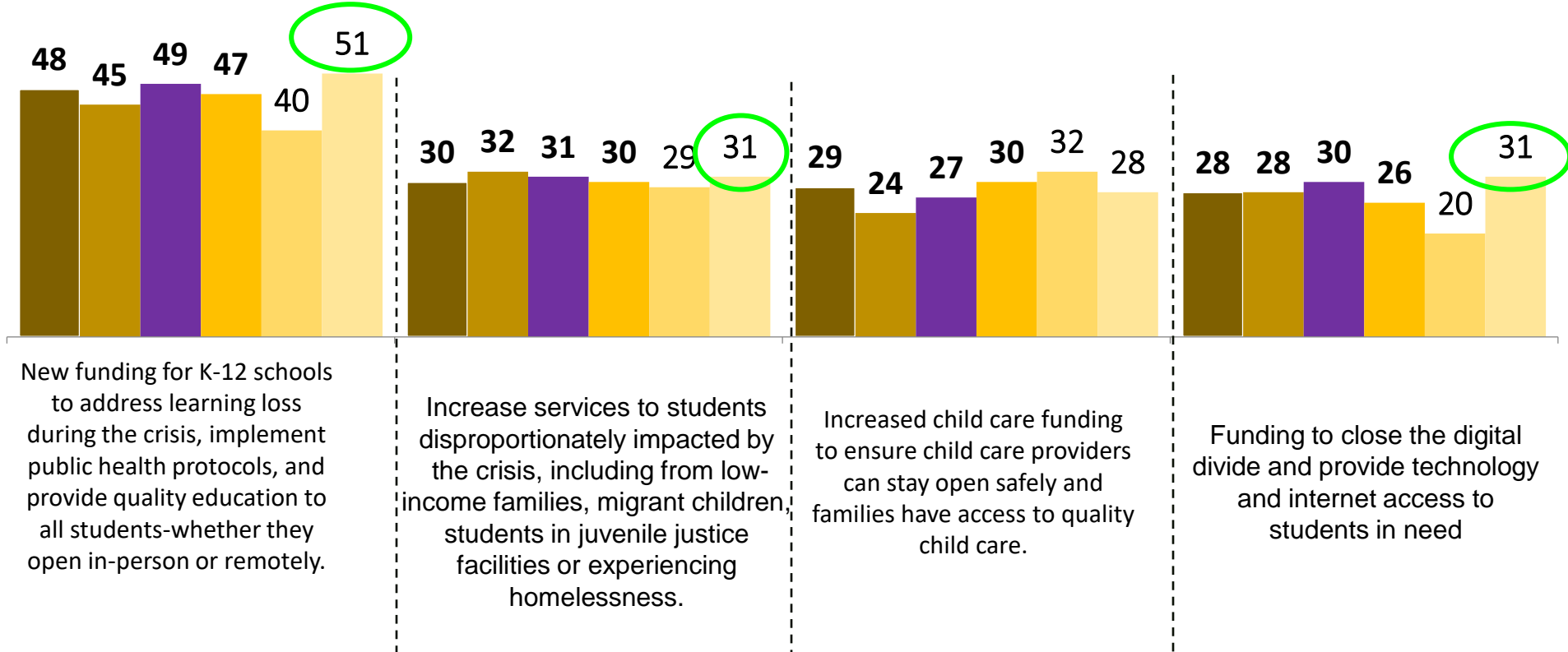
Equitable access to technology and resources to help students get quality education during the pandemic is a consistent concern in rural areas

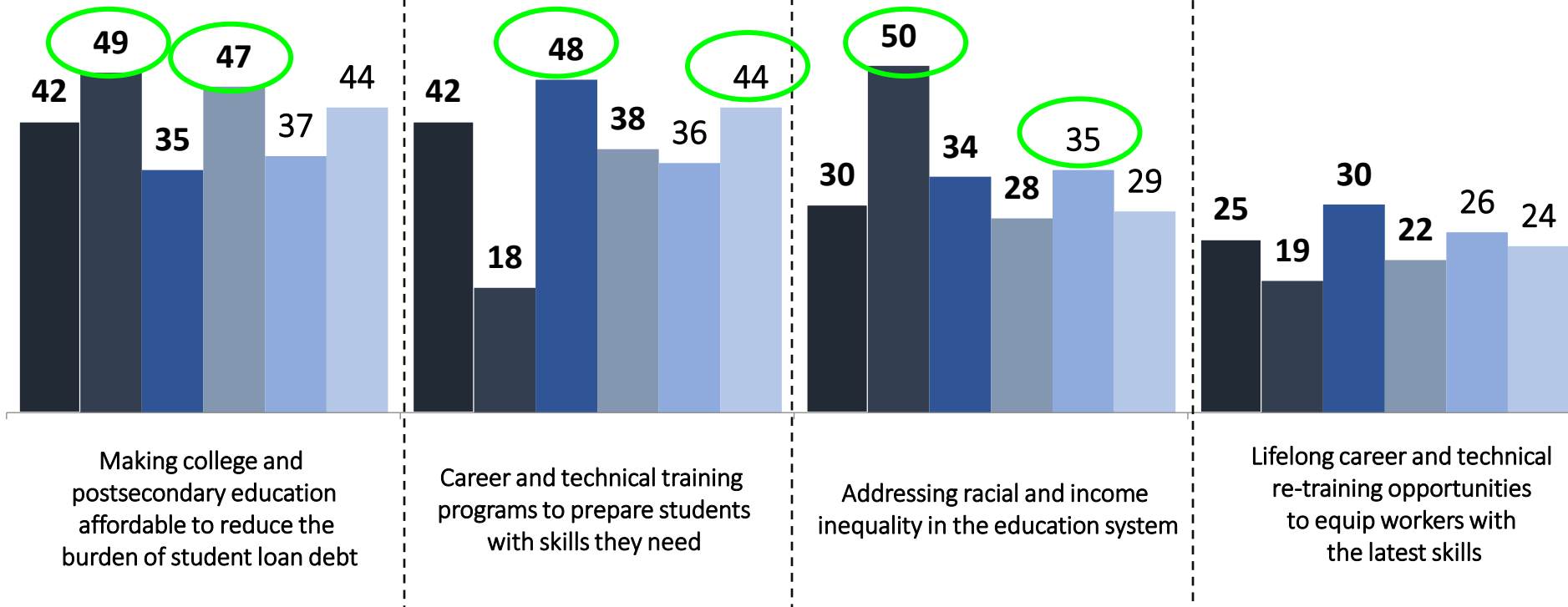

GA one of only states where expanding internet is stronger than redesign k-12, and unlike other states, this is driven by class as much as geography

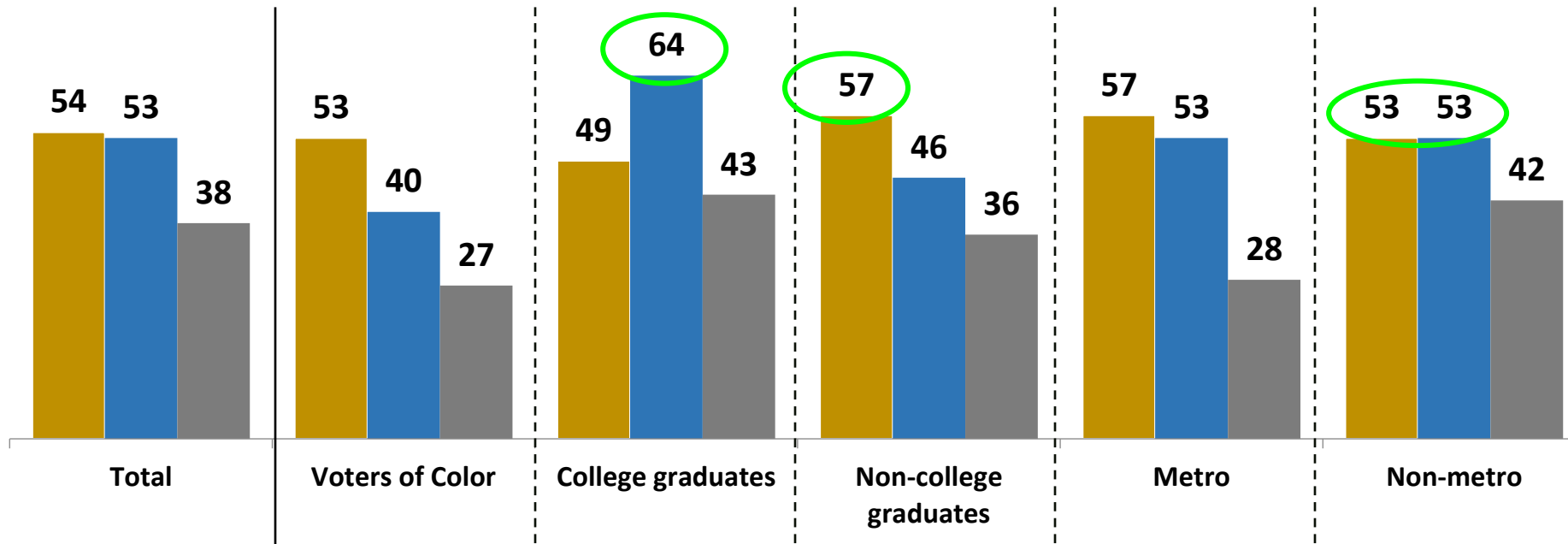
Let's say you wanted America to improve its current economic, healthcare and overcome national polarization through big changes in the education system. Which THREE of the proposals below would you choose?

BIG EDUCATION IDEAS

Expand affordable internet access to all Americans to the necessary education and training materials and services including, and provide appropriate hardware and software as needed, so that people have access to the learning, training and services they need throughout their lives.

Redesign the pre-K and k-12 experience so it includes strong components of problem solving, academics, the arts, mental and physical health, living skills, civics, and community activities, integrated into in-school and out of school experiences, based on the best research.

Recognize that this is the highest unemployment rate on record, and use this opportunity to retrain America for the future. And just like the Congress did for returning GIs in WWII, create a massive retraining program for the 52 million unemployed or 30 million collecting benefits



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
